Friday May 23, 2014: Welcome BBQ

The welcome BBQ begins at 6:30 at a private home just north of the town of Napa. Due to limited parking, we ask that **ALL GUESTS PLEASE USE THE SHUTTLE SERVICE** from the Andaz Hotel in Napa to the home on Big Ranch Road. For those who originally planned to drive, please use free self-parking at the Andaz Parking Structure (entrance at 1401 Clay Street, Napa, CA 94559) or \$20 valet parking in front of the Andaz Hotel (entrance at 1450 First Street, Napa, CA 94559) and take the shuttle which will be leaving every 15 minutes, beginning at 6:15pm. Shuttles will be running in a loop all evening.

Saturday May 24, 2014: Visit Yountville / Local Wineries

Saturday is your day to enjoy all that Napa Valley has to offer! Shuttles will be leaving the Andaz Hotel every 20 minutes beginning at 10am and looping through some of our favorite places: Domaine Chandon, the town of Yountville, Silverado Winery and Regusci Winery. Don't like one of those places? Don't want to stop? No problem, just stay on the shuttle and head to the next stop.

This trip has stops for everyone - regardless of whether or not you want to wine taste:

- Domaine Chandon Sparkling wine, beautiful gardens, an expansive indoor tasting room and outdoor patio, a restaurant, and a world-class art collection. If you're interested in wine tasting then head to the tasting room and grab a table inside or out on the patio for sparkling wine flights paired with small bites. If you're interested in gardens and art then enjoy walking the expansive property.
- Yountville The most charming town in the valley and a place you could easily spend the whole
 day! For guests with children, this is a great spot to enjoy the day with open grassy areas and
 places to enjoy for all ages. Grab a pastry and coffee at <u>Bouchon Bakery</u>, stop in at the many art
 galleries and boutiques like <u>Maisonry</u> and <u>V Marketplace</u>, enjoy a picnic lunch in Thomas

Head inside to see the dogs, enjoy the shop and have a formal tasting, or buy a bottle inside and enjoy it at our reserved picnic tables on the south side of the property.
- Napa If you don't feel like jumping on the shuttles, the town of Napa has plenty to offer to keep
 you busy all day. Ox Bow Public Market is Napa's version of Chelsea Market and has something
 for everyone from oysters to cupcakes. Gotts Roadside is an institution and has the best

Please note that cabs may be particularly busy during this holiday weekend.
